




STRIKE




- Individual and collective right.
- Conditions of validity: total stoppage of work, employee consultation, professional claims.
- Consequences: risk of disciplinary action or dismissal.

 The Americans have the right to strike, but under certain conditions and limitations.


CONTRACT TYPES






- Permanent contract
- Fixed-term contract

- Liberal and it is quite possible to work legally without a written contract of employment.
- Contract employee which specifies the duration and other terms,

WORKING HOURS





- 35 hours per week unless agreement
- 48 hours maximum per week
- US legislation does not indicate any limit on the number of hours worked per day, or per week.
- 40 hours a week.

OVERTIME





- Authorized
- From 1 hour to 8 hours : paid at 125%
- From 9 hours and more : paid at 150%

There is either financial compensation or compensation in rest.

- No limit in the Act on the number of hours employees
- The Act applies on a workweek basis.

Averaging of hours over two or more weeks is not permitted.
