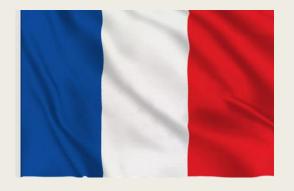

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## Holiday entitlement

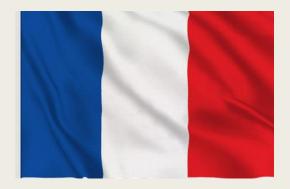
France	USA

#### Sick leave

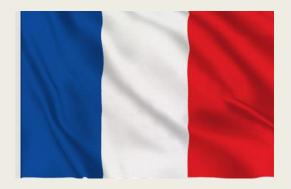
France	USA
<ul> <li>In the labor code</li> <li>no limit of sick leave</li> <li>Easy stop in sick leave</li> <li>sick leave is paid</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Not in the labor code</li> <li>Family And Medical Leave Act have 12 weeks a year of sick leave</li> <li>hard stop on sick leave</li> <li>no sick pay</li> </ul>





## Parental leave Maternity and paternity

France	USA
<ul> <li>Parental leave = 3 years per child</li> <li>Parental leave is paid</li> <li>Both parents or entitled</li> </ul>	There is not parental leave





# Termination / Dismissal Collective dismissal

<ul> <li>Several termination of employment:         resignation, individual and collective         mutually agreed severence, redundancy         individual and economic</li> <li>In labor code</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Employment At will</li> <li>Employment contract</li> <li>Negociation with employer</li> </ul>
