



The REsearch COOPerative

The *Research Cooperative* is an informal group of researchers from the Lezi Le Creusot, meeting twice a month on Thursday afternoon, to discuss and debate on research problems, communicate recent results from the team or share new advances of the state-of-the-art. Each session is led by a *session chair* who defined beforehand the type, topic, content, duration and expected outcomes.

Session type includes:

- **Conference:** a formal event where a researcher presents concepts, works and results.
- **Seminar:** a form of academic instruction which has the function of bringing together small groups for recurring meetings, focusing each time on some particular subject, in which everyone present is requested to actively participate.
- **Tutorial:** a method of transferring knowledge that may be used as a part of learning process (a kind of interactive course).
- **Working group:** an ad hoc group of subject-matter experts working together to achieve specified goals.
- **Brainstorming:** a group by which efforts are made to find a conclusion for a specific problem by gathering a list of ideas spontaneously contributed by its members.
- **Journal club:** a group of individuals who meet to critically evaluate recent articles in the academic literature.
- **Lightning talk:** a lightning talk is a very short presentation (a few minutes) of works, concepts and results.
- **Birds of a feather:** informal meeting where the attendees group together based on a shared interest and carry out discussions without any pre-planned agenda.
- **Demos:** showcasing applications, toolboxes, softwares or working systems.
