Propaganda Posters Project Rubric

Objective

SW create two pieces of Soviet propaganda that depict the two different view points of soviet people within Russia.

Directions

- 1. In order to help you recognize propaganda, you are going to create **two** propaganda pieces for **two** different newspapers.
- 2. One piece should be a statement in support of Stalin's policies and should be similar to the quote from *Pravda* at the beginning of this section (542).
- 3. The other piece should be a statement typical to what an illegal anti-Stalinist newspaper might have printed.
- 4. Both pieces need to have a typed and detailed newspaper article that incorporates facts about Stalin's policies in some way.
- 5. Both pieces need to have a detailed visual aid that coincides with the message in your newspaper article.

Parameters

- 1. Detailed Content with Specific Examples and Details
 - a. Has an obvious tone of either being in favor or against Stalin's policies.
 - b. Incorporates detailed examples of Stalin's policies
- 2. Visual Aid
 - a. Relevant to the message being delivered in the newspaper article.
 - b. Effort is shown to make the product look like a typical newspaper.

Point Values - 15 Points Each

- 1. Content
 - a. Obvious and correct tone of article 2 points
 - b. Details and Examples 8 points
- 2. Visual Aid
 - a. Relevant to message 4 points
 - b. Color 1 point
