



Viewing the Presentation

The video is **36 minutes** long. We will be providing you with a worksheet for your students to use during the presentation in order to take notes and follow along with the content in the presentation.

There is a breakout questions during the presentation: Whose prophecy came true: Orwell or Huxley? There is a one-minute timer in the presentation, but you may want to pause the video to give your students a little extra time to discuss their answers.

After the presentation, read the answers to the worksheet blanks out loud to make sure everyone caught everything.

Have your IT department test the set up and presentation at least 1 day before viewing, we would also recommend you as the facilitator to watch the presentation before the event at your school.

Axis+ requires an Internet enabled computer that is hooked up to an AV system. Your school or church may already have a set up that works great with Axis+. You and/or your IT department will know your system best. If you're not sure what you have/need, read the list below.

What You'll Need

An Internet enabled computer or device

A projector and screen or a TV

A sound system or external speakers

What To Do

After logging in to watch.axisplus.org, you will be taken to your Dashboard. Click on the event you purchased.

Preload/buffer the presentation at least **20 minutes** before viewing

Test sound levels prior to presentation

Click the full screen button on the video

Click play. Your virtual event will begin!
