

Expectations

RESPECT--PARTICIPATE--WORK FOR PRIDE

Daily Agenda--The daily agenda is posted in the upcoming section of Schoology everyday. You are expected to be looking at this when the bell rings and work independently on the first activity while I take attendance.

Writing Prompt--Everyday you will have a writing prompt to answer. This will typically start our class. You will write this in schoology and save a draft until the last day of the week when I tell you to submit all of the writing prompts for that week.

Individual Work time--During this time you are expected to work quietly and by yourself on the activity listed "individual time" within the agenda of Schoology.

Direct Instruction--Typically during direct instruction, I am either lecturing to you or giving you instructions on how to complete a certain activity. You are expected to be quiet during this time, take notes, and raise your hand and ask questions when you have them.

Partner/Group Work time--I will normally tell you who the individuals are that will be in your group. You are expected to stay on task and have the activity completed by the end of the time I have given you. Occasionally, I will have you evaluate group members using a group member rubric.

Large Group/Discussions--When we do these we will either keep the classroom structure as is (rows) or move the desks into circles. You are graded on participation that contributes to the discussion, the ability to actively listen, and being respectful to all individuals in the discussion.

History Lab--This is an activity that entails looking at primary sources from history and forming your own conclusions about an event. These will sometimes be done in groups, partners, or individually.

Leaving and Coming to Class--If you leave the class, you will sign out on the appropriate clipboard and sign back in when you return. You are allowed to leave 9 times a term without a pass. These can be used for bathroom, locker, etc. If you do not use all 9 opportunities, these become extra credit points applied to participation at the end of the term. If coming to class late you must have a pass from wherever you were.
