## Journal Entry Assignment World History & Leadership

**Objective:** SW utilize the skill of self reflection by completing one journal entry per week on the topics of their choosing.

**Procedure:** Please review the procedure that is listed below in order to complete your Journal Entry Assignment.

- 1. A list of topics will be given to you at the beginning of each week for your current unit.
  - a. You must complete one journal entry per week.
  - b. You may choose to write your journal entry on any topic that is covered during the week.
- 2. When writing your journal entry, you should focus on the following ideas, concepts, and questions.
  - a. What are your reactions to the material that you read or learned?
  - b. What kind of emotions were you feeling during class?
  - c. Once the information was able to "soak in" did it change your perspective or your thoughts on the material?
  - d. Has learning this material changed or enhanced your own perspective? How?
  - e. How has learning this material opened you to the perspectives of others?
  - f. Can you personally apply your experiences during class to your life as a leader or a community member?
  - g. If there was more that you wanted to learn about the subject, what kinds of questions would you want to ask?
- 3. You must complete your journal entriy according to the following parameters.
  - a. Must be typed, double-spaced, 12-point font.
  - b. Your header must be in the format of, "Mr. Croley's History Header."
    - i. You must include the date of the class period and the topic discussed during that class as your subject within your header
    - ii. John Smith History of Prussia (4/7/14) April 13, 2014
  - c. Your reflection must be at least 300 words.
  - d. Your reflection assignments must be electronically submitted **no later than** 7:00 PM every Sunday.
