



AXIS+ BASIC TECHNICAL SETUP

Axis+ requires an Internet-enabled computer that is hooked up to an AV system. Your school, church, or home may already have a set up that works great with Axis+. You, your IT department, and/or your high school student will know your system best. If you're not sure what you have/need, read the list below.

What You'll Need

1. An Internet-enabled computer or device
2. A projector and screen or a TV
3. A sound system or external speakers

Examples of what this may look like:

- A projector, sound system, and desktop computer
- A projector, external speakers, and laptop computer
- A TV, sound system, and desktop computer
- A TV, external speakers, and laptop computer

We recommend that you test playing the video through your specific system **at least 1 day in advance** of when you plan to show the event.

We also recommend allowing the video to buffer several minutes before you start the event.

Be sure audio levels are high enough to be comfortably heard!

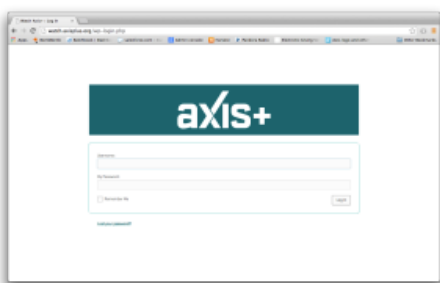
USING AXIS+ IN 4 EASY STEPS

How to watch a virtual event:

Step 1

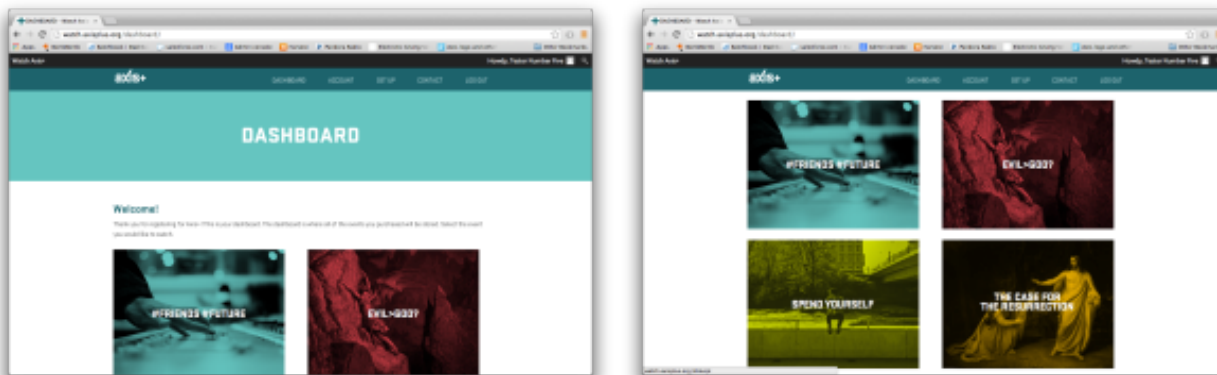
On the Internet-enabled computer or device that is hooked up to your AV system of choice, open a web browser. (We recommend Google Chrome or Apple Safari.)

Go to watch.axisplus.org and click on "Log In." (If you are not already registered, you will need to visit watch.axisplus.org/account to register.) (You will login with the username and password that was created when registering for Axis+)



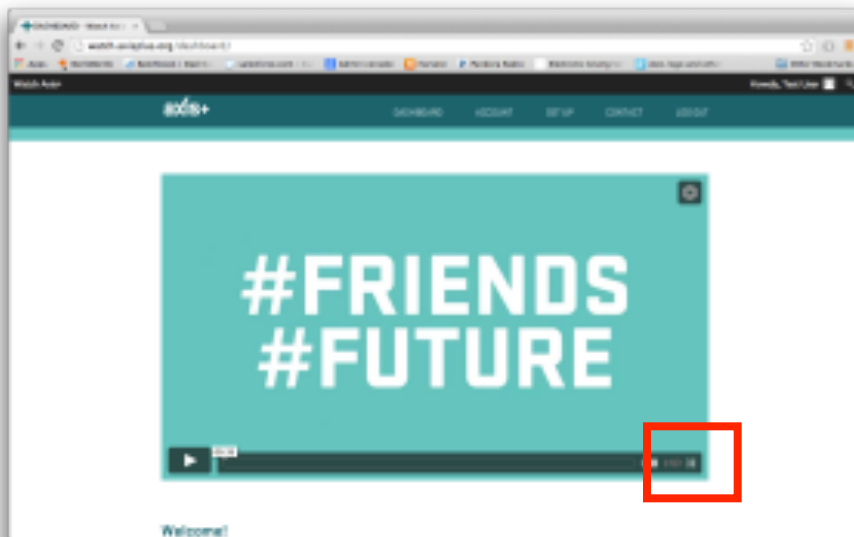
Step 2

After logging in, you will be taken to your Dashboard. Click on the event you want to view.



Step 3

Click the full screen button on the video.



Step 4

Click play. Your virtual event will begin.
