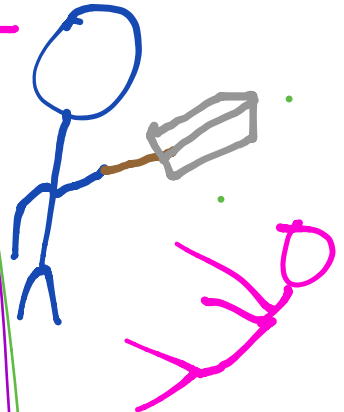

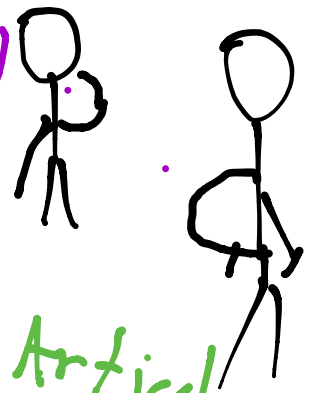
• What was the significance of Hatshepsut's role

- Capital moved south to Memphis  
 - Egypt expanded south  
 - Hatshepsut first female pharaoh  
 - Trade of Egypt  
 - Made first obelisks in her name  
 - Hatshepsut "pissed parade"  
 - Akhenaten realistic art

- Hatshepsut introduced trade and obelisks to Egypt  
 - Akhenaten realistic portraits of the pharaohs and made monotheism

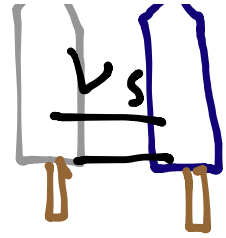


"That nose removed" Nefertiti
